CHUN WO HOLDS GROUNDBREAKING CEREMONY TO KICK OFF IMPROVEMENT PROJECT OF FUK MAN ROAD NULLAH IN SAI KUNG TODAY

FIRST PROJECT UNDER NEW GOVERNMENT CONTRACT TERMS

(Hong Kong, 5 February 2010) — **Chun Wo Development Holdings Limited** ("Chun Wo" or "the Group") (stock code: 711) held a groundbreaking ceremony today for the improvement project of Fuk Man Road Nullah in Sai Kung, the first project under the New Engineering Contract implemented by the Hong Kong Government.

The ceremony marking the beginning of works on the project was officiated by Mr. W H Ko, Deputy Director of Drainage Services Department, Mr. Ng Sze-fuk, SBS, JP, Chairman of the Sai Kung District Council, Mr. WAN Yuet-kau, JP, Vice Chairman of the Sai Kung District Council, Mr. Lok Shui-sang, Chairman of the Sai Kung Rural Committee, Mr. Wu Kam-yin, JP, District Officer of Home Affairs Department, Ms. Wu Kam-man, District Lands Officer, Mr. Wong Shu-yan, District Leisure Manager of Sai Kung, Mr. Lau Ngai Fai, Director of Black & Veatch Hong Kong Limited and Mr. Clement Kwok, Managing Director of Chun Wo.

Mr. Clement Kwok, Managing Director of Chun Wo, said, "Chun Wo's participation in improvement project of Fuk Man Road Nullah paves the way for taking part in the first project under the new contract arrangements implemented by the government. I believe the new cooperation mode will not only assure the highest cost-effectiveness of the project, but will also strengthen the partnership among the government, the engineering consultants and contractors, which will in turn raise the efficiency of the project and speed up related works. The project will contribute to the vitality of Sai Kung and bring green elements into environment of the district. In the future, Chun Wo will continue to seize opportunities to take part in more government infrastructure projects thereby contribute to the well-being of the community."

Project on Fuk Man Road, of contract worth around HK\$49.8 million, is expected to be completed in mid-2012. Related works include turning a 180-meter open drainage into a covered drainage on Fuk Man Road and improving the hygiene and outlook of the surrounding

environment, construction of drainage and the roundabout on Fuk Man Road and moving the bus stop away from the roundabout to ease traffic congestion in the town centre of Sai Kung.
