(Hong Kong, 29 April 2011) – Chun Wo Development Holdings Limited (“Chun Wo” or “the Group”) (stock code: 711) has announced that the Group has been honoured as “Manpower Developer” under the “ERB Manpower Developer Award Scheme” organised by Employees Retraining Board (“ERB”). Chun Wo does not only participate in the training & development activities as participants, but is also committed to develop the competency of their staff by designing the structure of Management Trainee program and instructing different sessions.

**Mr Dominic Pang, Chairman of Chun Wo**, said, “Chun Wo is honoured to receive this title and the recognition, it shows for all of our efforts we have devoted to enhancing our employees’ competency and building a better corporate culture.
