# Organised by Lifewire and co-organised by Chun Wo "Lifewire Run 2019" Charity Run cum Carnival A happy gathering in Shatin to support children with rare diseases

(10 November 2019, Hong Kong) — Organised by Lifewire and co-organised by Chun Wo Development Holdings Limited ("Chun Wo"), the "Lifewire Run 2019" Charity Run cum Carnival was held with great success this morning at On Muk Street Garden, Shek Mun, Shatin. More than 1,700 runners took part in the races and more than 100 organisations sponsored and joined the event, raising about HK\$2,000,000, which will be donated to Lifewire (excluding expenses) to support children with rare diseases and promote public awareness of those diseases.

Ir Lam Sai Hung, JP, Permanent Secretary for Development (Works); Dr. Ko Wing Man, GBS, JP, member of the National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (Medical and Health Sector) and former Secretary for Food and Health, artists Ms. Jacquelin Ch'ng and Ms. Griselda Yeung, Ir Dr. Pang Yat Bond, Derrick, JP, Founder of Lifewire, and other committee members of Lifewire, who officiated the event, joined the runners in urging the community to support and give cheer to children suffering from rare diseases.

Ir Lam Sai Hung, JP, said, "I am very pleased to attend "Lifewire Run 2019" today. The overwhelming response of more than 1,700 runners participating shows that the event is widely popular. In addition, I would like to express my appreciation to Lifewire, which has already raised more than HK\$10 million since its establishment 5 years ago, for supporting children affected by and promoting social awareness in rare diseases."

Dr. Ko Wing Man, GBS, JP, said, "In recent years, with the promotion by Lifewire and other charity organizations, the society and the government are increasingly aware of the problem of rare diseases. Given the rising attention of the international community, I believe there will be more research dedicated to the effective treatment for rare disease in future."

Ir Dr. Pang Yat Bond, Derrick, JP, Founder of Lifewire, said, "As the Lifewire Run steps into its third year, we continue to raise funds to help children afflicted by rare diseases as well as their families. I wish to thank all runners who have taken part in this worthwhile charity event. Each step will give strong support and encouragement to these patients and their family members. I hope that everyone will embrace the Hong Kong spirit of caring for all and helping each other in the community, and continue to spread the concept of an inclusive society."







This year's Lifewire Run included races of 1km, 3km and 10km, and runners could join as individuals, represent their schools in the inter-school races and in corporate teams. On top of the races, the event also featured a unique Hong Kong-style carnival with a nostalgic 4D area for photo-taking, and game and snack booths reminiscent of the "Lai Chi Kok Amusement Park" from the old days that brought back sweet collective memories. It was a meaningful day for the runners as well as Shatin residents, and friends and families who joined the event.
